Saint Lucia

- **Number of Persons to be accepted:** 80 persons in the first instance. Total to be determined.
- Accommodation: Starfish Quarantine Facility followed by private homes certified by the Government of Saint Lucia
- Transportation Arrangements: To Be Announced
- Required documents:
 - o Driver's license, National ID card or passport
 - Persons are encouraged to provide immunization records or medical records so that they can be benefit optimally from health services.

• COVID-19 Requirements:

- o COVID-19 tests will be done on arrival.
- Must complete 3-5 days quarantine period at the state's "Starfish" facility.
- Vaccination not required. Provision will be made to receive second dose
 of vaccine in Saint Lucia for those with inoculation card.
