

5.	ANDORRA (PRINCIPALITY OF)	Business/Vacation – No Employment –No Other- No	Andorra tourist visa is not required for citizens of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines for a stay up to 90 days. The Principality of Andorra is not a member of the Schengen Area. Access to the Principality is made through France or Spain. Thus, any national from a third-country travelling to Andorra must get information from the French or Spanish Embassies or Consulates (depending on the country of entrance) about the need of a Schengen visa, and when deemed necessary, about the visa obtaining procedures. When the Schengen visa is required, third-country nationals shall apply for a double-entry or a multiple entry Schengen visa depending on how many times you will enter the Schengen area from Andorra.

You can use a credit or debit card, but you can also use a Paypal account if you have one.</li> <li>A valid e-mail address – the <u>Azerbaijan e-visa</u> will arrive via email in the timeframe you choose during the application process. • You must use a visit eVisa within 30 days of its approval (after this time the eVisa will expire and you will have to apply again and pay another fee)
Working Visas:
<ul> <li>Work visas are issued based on the Non-Objection Certificate (N.O.C) issued by the General Directorate of Nationality, Passports and Residence in the Kingdom of Bahrain.</li> <li>Working Visas cannot be issued without taking prior approval from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.</li> </ul>
The eVisas are valid for two weeks, but can be extended on application. You can also get a longer three-month visa by applying on arrival in Bahrain.
