<p>SHARE WITH CAUTION – If you keep yourself logged into shopping sites on your home device, ask that guests use a different browser!</p>	<p>SHARED WiFi = UNSECURED WiFi – Everything from an online bank statement to a Gmail account can be compromised when surfing the Web on a shared WiFi network.</p>	<p>VERIFY ALL URLS – the URL on shopping sites should be encrypted, that is, read "https" rather than "http."</p>	<p>QUESTION EVERY SITE – Genuine companies will have active social accounts and an online conversation in place with consumers.</p>	<p>KEEP PAYMENT METHODS SEPARATE FROM BANK ACCOUNTS – opt for credit not debit card payments (better against fraud).</p>	<p>THINK BEFORE YOU SHARE DEVICES – Very often consumers save usernames, passwords and banking information – this may not be too wise.</p>
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
