HIGH COMMISSIONER OF INDIA VISITS SAINT VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES

SAINT VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES, January 16, 2026 —His Excellency Subhash Prasad Gupta, High Commissioner of India to Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, was on an official visit for the period January 14 to 16, 2026.

On January 15, 2026, High Commissioner Gupta held a courtesy meeting with Governor-General, His Excellency Stanley Kendrick John, KC at Government House Old Montrose, Kingstown.

Additionally, His Excellency participated in a joint courtesy call with the Prime Minister of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, the Honourable Dr. Godwin Friday, and the Foreign Minister, the Honourable Dwight Fitzgerald Bramble. The meeting was also attended by Mrs. Sandy Peters-Phillips, Permanent Secretary in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Foreign Trade, Foreign Investment and Diaspora Affairs; Mrs. Charmane Tappin-John, Director of Foreign Policy; and Mr. Emil Dougan, Senior Foreign Service Officer. Discussions focused on the bilateral relations between the two states.

High Commissioner Gupta reviewed the progress of the ongoing Quick Impact Projects funded by the Government of India, including the rehabilitation of the Dauphine Community Centre, the Netball Hardcourt in Edinboro, and the gymnasium at the Central Leeward Secondary School.

The Government and people of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines continues to value India's commitment to development cooperation and collaboration in both bilateral and multilateral fora.
