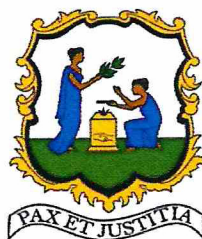

THE ALLIANCE OF SMALL ISLAND STATES (AOSIS) FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME 2024

SAINT VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES, October 19th, 2023 – The Alliance of Small Island States (AOSIS) Fellowship Programme 2024 provides the opportunity for young professionals from AOSIS countries to get hands on training on relevant issues of law, policy, and science to build enduring capacity in AOSIS member governments to engage on issues regarding climate change, oceans and sustainable development.

In 2024, the Fellowship Programme will train a new class of ten (10) Fellows in climate change, oceans, environmental protection and sustainable development issues and the international process. If selected, the Fellow will work from the Permanent Mission of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines to the United Nations in New York and will work both on national and AOSIS priorities.

Applicants are required to submit their applications, inclusive of the application form, cover letter and writing sample to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Foreign Trade: office.foreignaffairs@mail.gov.vc and svgforeign@gmail.com by Tuesday, December 5, 2023 for review and transmission ahead of deadline. Only one candidate from Saint Vincent and the Grenadines will be submitted.

The new class of Fellows will begin in February 2024, in New York, and selection is expected to be made by the AOSIS Bureau by late December.
