SAINT VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS INTO MEXICO

1. Valid passport or travel document.

Nationals of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines require a visa.

2. Valid visa, which must be requested before entering Mexican territory at any Mexican consular office abroad. Visa requirements can be found at the following link: <https://www.gob.mx/sre/acciones-y-programas/visas-para-extranjeros-8036>

3. Or one of the following documents:

a. Document proving **permanent residence** in Canada, the United States of America, Japan, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, or any of the countries that make up the Schengen Area and/or the member countries of the Pacific Alliance; or,

b. **Valid and current visa** from Canada, the United States of America, Japan, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, or any of the countries that make up the Schengen Area; or,

c. **APEC (ABTC) Business Travel Card** approved by Mexico; or,

d. **Seaman's Book**, if a member of the maritime crew; or,

e. **Aircrew Member**.

***Countries belonging to the Schengen Area:** Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, and Switzerland.

***Countries of the Pacific Alliance:** Chile, Colombia, and Peru, in addition to Mexico.

4. Also, if required, provision of supporting documentation regarding the purpose of your trip, such as:

a. Proof of accommodation (reservation and confirmation) to verify your address and length of stay in Mexico.

- b. Return tickets (transportation for your departure, based on the number of days declared in Mexico).
- c. Tour tickets and itinerary of activities that will be carried out in Mexico.
- d. Means of subsistence during your stay in the country.
- e. Place of usual residence or place of origin.
- f. Activities you engage in in your country or place of origin.
- g. Any other information and personal data that may be required.
- h. If applicable, an invitation letter from the company, institution, or person(s) inviting you, which should include the following:
 - Purpose of the visit,
 - Biographical information of the invited persons,
 - Entry and exit dates from the country (travel itinerary),
 - Address of the accommodation,
 - Name, email address, copy of identification, and contact number located within the national territory (since, in case of doubt, the immigration authority will verify the information using the provided telephone number).

IMPORTANT POINTS

- a. The temporary permit granted by the immigration authority can range from 1 to 180 days, depending on the information provided and verified during the immigration control procedure.
- b. This temporary permit must be fulfilled in a timely manner.
- c. The entry requirements are the same as those required at all international airports in the country.
- d. Entry into Mexico may take longer in some cases. The speed of processing at the immigration checkpoint will depend on passengers presenting the required information which determines the motive of his/her trip.
