**TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE CREATIVE ARTS COMPETITION**

**CATEGORIES: BANANA ART, METAL, WOOD, PAINTING, IMITATION CAKES (MADE FROM STYROFOAM, CARD BOARD, ETC. AND DECORATED WITH ICING)**

This competition involves the submission of items made from the specified material in the categories above. All entries **MUST** be based on the theme and reflect some aspect of Information Communication Technology (ICT).

- ♦ ALL entrants **MUST** register for the competition. Registration forms are available online at [www.gov.vc](http://www.gov.vc) or at the Information Technology Services Division (I.T.S.D.), located on the top floor of the Income Tax Building. **Completed Registration Forms must be returned to the Information Technology Services Division on or before Monday 12th May 2014.**
- ♦ Entries **MUST ONLY** be submitted on the morning of the Expo and entrants are responsible for arranging and securing their entries **for the duration of the Expo.**
- ♦ Entries must be submitted between 8:30 and 11:00 a.m.
- ♦ There is no entry fee to enter this competition.
- ♦ Prizes will be awarded to winners.
- ♦ Winners would be announced **on the day of the Expo** at 4:30 p.m. and prizes awarded at a short prize-giving ceremony on site.
- ♦ No part of a prize is exchangeable for cash or any other prize.
- ♦ The competition is not opened to employees of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Foreign Trade, Commerce & Information Technology.
- ♦ Each entrant is only allowed one entry per category.
- ♦ Entrants are allowed to sell their entries **BUT** the purchasers can only collect them after the prize-giving ceremony.
- ♦ **Winning entries would be kept by the organisers for two (2) months to be displayed in public places after which they would be returned.**
- ♦ Entry into the competition will be deemed as acceptance of these terms and conditions and an indication of an entrant's agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.
