

## NOTE TO THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF HUNGARY

In relation to the news disseminated about interventionist statements by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Hungary, injuring the Sovereignty of Nicaragua and meddling in the affairs of the Nicaraguan State, with this Note we are strongly protesting against the violation of the Vienna Convention by the Government of Hungary.

Nicaragua, with a very high cost in Lives, with so much blood shed in defense of the Right to National Sovereignty, and with

centuries of courage and bravery in Antiimperialist and Anti-interventionist
Struggles, strongly demands the Head of
Government of Hungary and the Head of Relations
with other States, for meddling in matters
that neither concern them nor are of their
competence. From that other Continent, Hungary
seems to be following the warmongering and
slave-owning footsteps of the European
Empires.

Statements by the Minister of Foreign Affairs
Péter Szijjártó reflect ignorance about the
accurate relationships between Sovereign States
and an excessive protagonist desire that
neither looks good on them nor can they have,
according to the Charters of International
Organizations that provide guidelines on
respect, harmonious coexistence, and above
all, decency and sanity so as not to seek

prominence with immature and inappropriate behavior, at the expense of National Sovereignties.

Nicaragua has never intervened in the affairs of another Country, nor will we, because we have Consciousness and Duty to safeguard our own and others' Rights. We demand reciprocity.
